

Governance structure 25+5 SDG Cities Leadership Plattform

After the initial phase the 25+5 will be organized as IGO. The overall budget of the 25+5 SDG Cities Leadership Platform is starting with 10 Mio € p.a. originating from the 25 annual membership fees of 100.000€ each per city as well as the 100.000€ per each future cities and the 10 Global Industry Excellence Partners paying their annual membership fee of 500.000€.

The budget covers 3 Mio € onboarding and ongoing costs for the 20 Experts (150.000€ each); 3 Mio to cover the costs of the data base regarding measuring progress of the SDG implementation in each city; 1.5 Mio € to cover the costs of the annual conferences in Davos, New York and Geneva, 1.5 Mio € to cover the costs creating and maintaining an ongoing information progress exchange and best-practice exchange among the 25+5 SDG Cities) and 1 Mio € to cover the cities empowerment program. It illustrates already the value for money for each city: as they receive these services and contribute only with 1% to this annual budget.

The 25+5 Supervisory Committee is in charge of monitoring the execution and control of the budget. While receiving quarterly Status Quo and Progress reports the Supervisory Committee is meeting twice per year and will report to the 25+5 once per year no later than March 30 of the following of each calendar year. The 25+5 Supervisory Committee represents one of the 25+ Cities, one representative of the regional representation, one representative of the UN, one representative of the 20 SDG Experts, one representative of the University Partners, one representative of the Education Program, one representative of GlobeEthics, Geneva, ensuring that all global standards are respected and one representative of the 25+5 top management.
